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## **HOW TO: Bind Off a Cable**

When binding off a cable (as at a shoulder seam or at the end of an afghan), knit the two middle stitches together as you bind off to keep the edge from flaring.

If the cable is an extremely wide one, you may need to work the k2tog twice along each cable section.

To keep the edge smooth, you might also want to work the bind off about half way through the cable repeat, at the widest part of the cable.

Working the bind off right after the cable turn can leave lumpiness, and right before the cable turn can lead to additional flaring. Go for the middle, and use the k2tog to keep a smooth, non- flaring edge.
