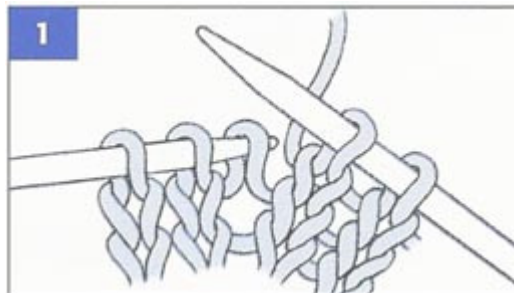


HOW TO: M1

The Make One, a simple increase that is worked between two stitches, is one of the greatest mysteries to new knitters. It is not as hard as the words make it seem. Try following these easy steps, or if you prefer, stop by the shop. We are always interested in teaching someone a new technique.

M1 = MAKE ONE

This almost invisible increase is called 'Make One'. Work to the place where the increase is to be made. Insert the left needle from front to back into the horizontal strand between the two stitches:



Knit the stitch through the back loop as shown.
